जैसा कि विदित है कि दिनांक "09 नवम्बर, 2018" को विधिक सेवा दिवस है और गत वर्षों की भाँति इस वर्ष भी माननीय न्यायाधिपति एवं कार्यकारी अध्यक्ष महोदय, राजस्थान राज्य विधिक सेवा प्राधिकरण के निर्देशानुसार विधिक सेवा दिवस को विशेष आयोजन के साथ 04 नवम्बर, 2018 से 10 नवम्बर, 2018 तक मनाया जाना एक्शन प्लान 2018—19 में प्रस्तावित है।

विधिक सेवा प्राधिकरण अधिनियम, 1987 दिनांक 09.11.1995 को पूरे राष्ट्र में प्रभावी रूप से लागू हुआ था। यह दिवस विधिक सेवा के विभिन्न कार्यक्रमों व योजनाओं की आम जन को विधिक जानकारी कराने के लिए तथा गत वर्ष सम्पादित किये गये विभिन्न कार्यक्रमों के मूल्यांकन के साथ आगामी वर्ष में क्रियान्वित की जाने वाली विभिन्न योजनाओं के प्रति जन जागृति उत्पन्न करने के लिए आयोजित किए जाएंगे। विधिक सेवा सप्ताह के दौरान विधिक जागरूकता के प्रचार प्रसार के क्रम में निम्नांकित माध्यम अपनाये जाना प्रस्तावित है—

Legal Awareness Day for children" [14th November, 2018]

It is our pride privilege that Hon'ble Mr. Justice K.S. Jhaveri Sb., Senior Judge, Rajasthan High Court and Executive Chairman, RSLSA has approved the proposal for organizing "Legal Awareness Day for children" on 14th November, 2018.

Therefore, all the Chairmen, DLSA's, Full Time Secretaries, DLSAs, PLVs, Panel Advocates, Legal Awareness Teams are being directed to organize "Legal Awareness Day for children" on 14th November, 2018 in all Districts & Tehsils of State of Rajasthan with the assistance of Bharat Scouts & Guides, school students, NGOs etc.

In this "Legal Awareness Day for children", following programmes are proposed to be organized:-

- (a) Organization of rally with the assistance of Bharat Scout & Guides & School students. The school Students may takes Posters, Banners, display boards etc. regarding "stop child marriage", "educate the girls child", "stop ragging", "stop child labour", "beware of blue whale challenges" and other issues relating to children so that the general public may be aware and sensitized about the child rights.
- (b) The Full Time Secretaries, legal awareness teams, panel advocates and PLVs may organize legal awareness camp in schools, collages etc. to spread awareness regarding rights and duties of the children.

" An Year of "Child Rights" 2018-19 "

India with 1.34 billion people constitutes as the second most populous country in the world and children represent 39% of total population of the country. Rajasthan is a home to 2.98 Crores children which is 43.6 percent of the total state population. Although children are only 39 percent of the population but they are 100 percent of our future, therefore we cannot afford to ignore the children.

Nobel Laureate Gurudev Rabindranath Tagore has written that "Every child comes with the message that God is not yet discouraged of man." We worry about what a child will become tomorrow, yet we forget that he is someone today. Children are one of the greatest assets any nation possesses. Their wellbeing and growth is an important indicator of its social and economic development.

All children have a right to care and protection; to develop and grow into a complete and full individual, regardless of their social and economic situation.

Nelson Mandela, former President of South Africa has said, "Safety and security don't just happen, they are the result of collective consensus and public investment. We owe our children, the most vulnerable citizens in our society, a life free of violence and fear."

Every child has a fundamental right to elementary education under Article 21A of the Constitution of India. The right to education is a directive principal of state policy under Article 45 and fundamental duty under Article 51A of Constitution of India, enforcement of Article 21A of the Indian Constitution, which provides for compulsory education, can be highlighted to ensure that children are not left without the benefits of education.

The childhood of a person is precious. On the child attaining the age of majority, anything may be given to it like the job, house,



husband/wife; but what cannot be got back is its precious childhood. One of the most important tenets of Child Rights is ensuring their basic right to good health, nutrition, education and freedom from violence, abuse and exploitation.

Therefore this Authority has decided to celebrate year 2018-19 as Year of Child Rights to ensure better future for our children.
